Hanging Your Quilt -

All quilts must have a 4" hanging sleeve (sewn or basted securely at top and bottom of sleeve) attached to the back top and must be **no more than 88" from the bottom of the quilt to the top of the sleeve** (because our pipe is only 8' tall). Wall quilts must have a sleeve (minimum of 1") or loops appropriate to their size. All quilts must be labeled on the back with the name of the owner/entrant.

Selling Your Quilt -

If you would like to sell your project, provide us with whatever contact info you want to share and then you and the purchaser can work out the details.
