Hanging Your Quilt

All quilts must have a 4" hanging sleeve (sewn or basted securely at top and bottom of sleeve) attached to the back top and must be **no more than 88" from the bottom of the quilt to the top of the sleeve** (our pipe is only 8' tall). Wall quilts must have a sleeve (minimum of 2") or loops appropriate to their size. All quilts must be labeled on the back with the name of the owner/entrant.

Selling Your Quilt

If you would like to sell your project, provide us with whatever contact info you want to share and then you and the purchaser can work out the details.
